"BACK TO THE FUTURE – Enhancing Futures Literacy through Interactive MOOCs in the Western Balkans" is an ambitious project that seeks to equip university students in the Western Balkans with Futures Literacy - a transformative skill for understanding and shaping the future. Through the development of interactive Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), the project will explore critical topics such as digital transformation, climate activism, media literacy and human rights. These courses will be implemented twice - once in the second year and repeated in the third year, reaching diverse cohorts of students across North Macedonia, Serbia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Albania, and Montenegro. By fostering intercultural dialogue and collaboration among students from six countries, the project aims to build a network of empowered young individuals capable of addressing regional challenges and driving innovation. With top experts from partner universities engaged in designing high-quality content, "BACK TO THE FUTURE" aspires to create lasting educational resources and inspire a new generation of forward-thinking leaders. This initiative represents a bold step toward transforming education in the Western Balkans, empowering youth to actively shape their futures while embracing uncertainty with confidence.
